With four spacious decks of exceptional elegance, abundant outdoor lounging areas and first-class pampering from the crew, pegasus endorses the guests' effortless delight in the beauty of the sea. Carefully designed down to the last detail, this superyacht has a unique sense of style that imbues the vessel with chic grandeur. Her 630 square meters of interior space allow both for privacy and intimacy on board. Innovative layouts allow for areas on board to be transformed instantly, creating a variety of new spaces for guests to wind down or gear up for a lively evening's entertainment. Engineered to the highest specifications, the yacht's performance has been enhanced with upgrades to the engines and operating systems. Thus equipped, pegasus transports its guests from bustling ports to forgotten bays for an unrivalled experience.







Equipped with two top-of-the-range marine engines, **pegasus** leaves other yachts in her wake. A good turn of speed means the vessel is suitable for weekend breaks, as well as longer cruises. 

Located on the Lower Deck are two VIP and three Twin cabins, each named after a different sea creature.
All of the guest cabins have been furnished with new silk carpets, wall fabrics, and leather ceilings,
lending warmth and light to the interiors. As well as en-suite facilities, each cabin is equipped with
a flat-screen television, state-of-the-art surround sound and iPod-ready music system.

Desks, night tables and cabinets are dressed in shagreen leather, echoing themes that run throughout the vessel. Furniture has been specially designed to slot together neatly, to keep walkways clear and enhance the space. Sliding Japanese screens evoke the serenity and minimalism of the East.





The three Twin cabins are completely versatile. All are equipped with Pullman berths. The twin bed easily converts to a double bed and the sofa can, in turn convert to a single bed. Combined with the clever design of the sliding desk, each of these identical cabins can be tailor-made to every guest's personal needs.






